

LRC Loyalty Card Scheme 2025



The LRC Loyalty Card Scheme is designed to help you develop these valuable skills and habits:

- Get into the habit of using the library and the library catalogue.
- Read books of your choice regularly.
- Develop your writing skills by writing structured reviews (you will find guidance to write great reviews below).
- Share your thoughts around your reading choices.

How it works

- Collect your loyalty card from the LRC.
- The LRC will issue a stamp on your card every time you borrow books (one stamp per borrowing instance, as opposed to one stamp per book issued).
- You need to collect twelve stamps throughout the year.
- You need to submit at least one book review on the library catalogue.
- Once you collect twelve stamps and post your reviews in the catalogue, you will be eligible to receive a prize. At the moment this is a £10 Amazon Gift Card.

How to write a winning review

- Reviews need to be no longer than 500 words (approximately 1x A4) and need to include:
 - A brief summary of the book
 - What you liked or disliked about it
 - Do you recommend it and why
 - A star rating
- If you need any help writing reviews or if you would like to have your reviews proofread before submitting, contact the lrc@stbrn.ac.uk.

Terms and conditions

- In order to receive a prize, you will need a clear library record (no overdue or lost books).
- One loyalty card per student per academic year.
- One stamp per borrowing instance.
- Cards are not transferable.
- The LRC reserves the right to stop the scheme if circumstances require so.
